

Vision Statement


- Be the global experts and trusted authority for technologies related to handling and optimizing data.

- Develop and promote architectures, standards, and education through vendor-neutral collaboration of experts on data technologies that lead the industry worldwide.






- Originally established in 1996 as the SCSI Trade Association.



- ~25 years ago
 - California banned smoking in bars and clubs
 - ICANN was formed
 - John Glenn flew on Discovery (STS-95)
 - First HD broadcast of live TV
 - Google founded; Google's first "Google Doodle" appeared
 - First MP3 player was released in Japan (SaeHan Information Systems)
 - Final episode of Seinfeld
 - *ER* was the most popular TV show
 - Bill Clinton was impeached; Augusto Pinochet was arrested
- In storage
 - USB Implementers Forum publishes USB Mass Storage Class; standardizes USB-based storage
 - NOR revenues exceeded \$2B; transition to NAND begins
 - ~750 million Flash chips ship
 - 1G Fibre Channel is standardized; 1G Optical Ethernet debuts




What does “Storage” mean?

- “Storage” means:
 - Capacity
- It also means:
 - Protection
 - Management
 - Transport
 - Performance
 - Memory handling
 - Locality
 - Abstraction
 - Longevity
 - Retrieval



Storage *is* Data. Data *is* Storage



- “Storage” is a *system that goes beyond media and capacity*
- Demographics are not the same as they were 25 years ago
 - Fewer “storage” companies
 - Explosive growth in “data” companies
 - What’s the difference?
 - *A lot of duplication of effort because of terminology confusion!*


